Requirements:

- Minimum of three to five years as a staff nurse, with three years of emergency nursing.

- Previous experience in the supervision of personnel, evaluation of the quality and appropriateness of nursing care, budget preparation and resource utilization beneficial.
- Possesses an active Wisconsin nursing license.
- BLS, ACLS, PALS certifications required within six months of hire.
